VVD BISTRO COLLECTION



About the designer VINCENT VAN DUYSEN




SL 58 & SLL18


SENSES COLLECTION


LUCCA & MONICA




This chair goes well with Lucca, a small yet convenient side table. The intuitive wooden handle allows the user to adjust the table's height or to carry the table.























H₂O




TAB LOUNGE




DAN RACK
