Following his cooperation with Neil Burley in 1988 and Marc Newson from 1988 to 1990, he opened his own studio in Brussels, where he currently works on projects all over the world. These objects give a new description to the space in which they are placed with respect and a sense of humour.

Created a mobile desk-seat called the Easy Rider. This is a unique piece that offers a variety of functions including lounging, working on a laptop, or simply sitting. It fits in a range of environments, from libraries, cafes to workplace collaboration. The Easy Rider is fully upholstered and the base is available in black or chrome, on castors or glides.

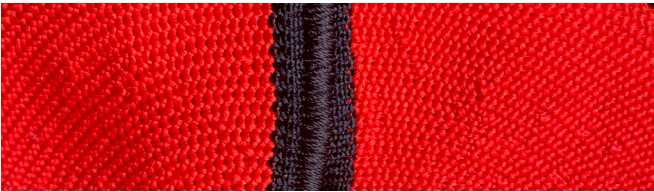

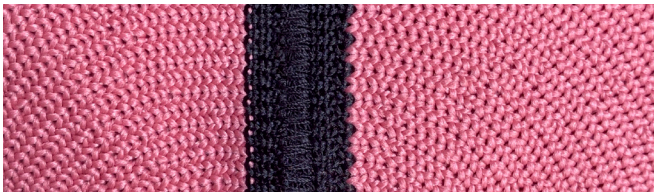

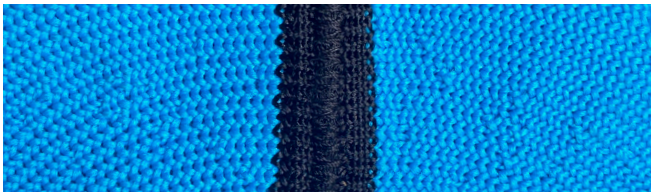
