Cleaning and Maintenance

Everyday care and maintenance

The fabric is best cleaned using a stiff brush or a vacuum cleaner with the appropriate attachment to avoid getting caught in the fabric with the sharp edges. You can also give the fabric a gentle rub with an almost dry shammy leather to restore the fabric's fresh look.

Stains

In all cases, prompt action is the key to cleaning any kind of fabric. The longer you leave it, the deeper the stain will be absorbed into the underlying layers.

Standard fabrics

- 1. Coffee stains
 - a) Detergent or shampoo for furniture upholstery fabrics
 - b) White spirit
 - c) A 2% borax solution, thinned in a coffee cup of hot water, to be applied with a coffee spoon and subsequently cleaned with tepid water.
- 2. Soft drinks
 - a) Detergent or shampoo for furniture upholstery fabrics
 - b) A 2% borax solution, thinned in a coffee cup of hot water, to be applied with a coffee spoon and subsequently cleaned with tepid water.
- 3. Ink
 - a) 90° alcohol disinfectant
 - b) Acetone, thinner
 - c) Biological detergent in a 1% solution (a coffee spoon in a coffee cup filled with tepid water)

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Corduroy

1. Liquid stains

Try dabbing the stain dry as much as possible using a clean cloth or some kitchen roll. Follow this up by applying a solvent-based cleaning product. Make sure you only dab – do not rub!

2. Other stains

Remove most of the dirt as best as you can before going over the stain again using a solvent-based cleaning product. Make sure you only dab – do not rub!

3. When the stains have fully dried, brush up the fabric pile.
Biro lines are best removed using a special ball-point remover (e.g. Beckman) to be applied onto a cotton cloth. Rub the cloth starting on the outside moving towards the centre. After you have finished, leave the fabric to dry in the air. However, please consider that any kind of pressure rubbing on pile fabrics (which includes corduroy) will inherently damage the pile.

General Information:

- 1. When using a soft, solvent-free cleaning product, we recommend you first try out the product on a small part of the fabric that is not exposed to view to test the agent's colourfastness before treating the actual stain.
- In case of severe soiling with mud or large stains we recommend calling on the services of a professional cleaning company.
