The duo designed several tables and systems for Bulo over the decades. H2O, dating back to 1993, has been a mainstay in Bulo's collections, adapting to new functions, scale and materiality as the world of technology and work developed.








Characterized by its' architectural form, with an extruded aluminum leg and steel support beams, the original design intent offered incremental height settings for the table tops, a detail now celebrated for it's floating, cantilevered effect.
