TABLES, DESKS AND WORKSTATIONS WITH ARCHITECTURAL STRUCTURE AND STORY

Interior designers Claire Bataille (1940) and Paul Ibens (1939-2020) worked together in the field of interior architecture for almost five decades. Through their joint design practice, established in 1968, they designed and realised countless homes, shops, businesses, furniture and objects.

The duo designed several tables and systems for Bulo over the decades. H2O, dating back to 1993, has been a mainstay in Bulo's collections, adapting to new functions, scale and materiality as the world of technology and work developed.



Characterized by its' architectural form, with an extruded aluminum leg and steel support beams, the original design intent offered incremental height settings for the table tops, a detail now celebrated for its floating, cantilevered effect.
